Title 18, District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, provides for the revocation of your District of Columbia driver's license or privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the District of Columbia for the following reason(s):

- Operation of a motor vehicle while apparently under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a drug, or while impaired by the consumption of alcohol, or while apparently physically or mentally unqualified to operate a motor vehicle by reason of diabetic coma, or epileptic or other seizure;
- Under 21 years of age and blood urine or breath contains any measureable amount of alcohol;
- Refusal to submit to two (2) chemical tests as required by the District of Columbia Implied Consent Act, effective September 14, 1982 D.C. Official Code 50 Section 1902 et. seq.;
- Ignition Interlock Device (IID) Violation:
 - Driving a vehicle without IID
 - Having a non-driver blow into IID
 - Tampering with IID

HEARING: You are entitled to apply for a hearing within ten calendar days (fifteen calendar days if you are not a resident of the District of Columbia) from the date of this notice. You may apply for a hearing in-person at 301 C Street, NW, Room 1157, Washington, DC 20001, Monday – Friday, 8:15am – 4:00pm.

ORDER OF REVOCATION: If you have not applied for a hearing as outlined above, it shall be unlawful for you to operate a motor vehicle in the District of Columbia until such time as your District of Columbia driver license or privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the District of Columbia has been officially reinstated. As required by Section 305 of Title 18, District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, District of Columbia driver license must be surrendered to the DC DMV immediately upon revocation.

Note: A fee of \$98 is required to reinstate your driver license or privileges. In addition, all outstanding debts and fines must be paid.
